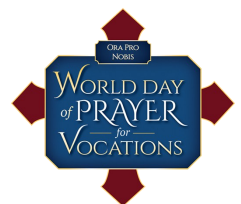


Mother Mary's 15 Promises of the Holy Rosary

1. Whoever shall faithfully serve me by the recitation of the Rosary, shall receive signal graces.
2. I promise my special protection and the greatest graces to all those who shall recite the Rosary.
3. The Rosary shall be a powerful armor against hell, it will destroy vice, decrease sin, and defeat heresies.
4. It will cause virtue and good works to flourish; it will obtain for souls the abundant mercy of God; it will withdraw the heart of men from the love of the world and its vanities, and will lift them to the desire of eternal things.
5. The soul which recommends itself to me by the recitation of the Rosary shall not perish.
6. Whoever shall recite the Rosary devoutly, applying himself to the consideration of its sacred mysteries, shall never be conquered and never overwhelmed by misfortune.
7. Whoever shall have a true devotion for the Rosary shall not die without the sacraments of the Church.
8. Those who are faithful to recite the Rosary shall have, during their life and at their death, the light of God and the plenitude of His graces; at the moment of death they shall participate in the merits of the saints in paradise.

– Good Shepherd Sunday

“I am the Good Shepherd. I know My sheep, and My sheep know Me.” (John 10:14)

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

This Sunday, as we celebrate Good Shepherd Sunday, we are reminded of Christ who knows each of us by name and lays down His life for His flock.

Today is also the World Day of Prayer for Vocations—a moment to pray that more hearts will respond to the call to serve as priests, deacons, and religious.

This week, our prayers are filled with even deeper joy and hope as we welcome the new Holy Father, Pope Leo XIV, the 267th successor of Saint Peter. Formerly known as Robert Francis Prevost, he was born in Chicago in 1955, joined the Augustinian Order, and later became a missionary bishop in Peru, where he also gained citizenship. Most recently, he served the universal Church as the Prefect of the Dicastery for Bishops.

His choice of the name “Leo” signals continuity with strong and courageous papal leadership, particularly recalling St. Leo the Great, known for defending the faith and promoting unity. In this new chapter of the Church, Pope Leo XIV brings with him a heart formed by missionary experience, pastoral sensitivity, and deep humility.

Although we are just beginning to know him, we are already invited to support him as our universal shepherd. As faithful Catholics, we are called to pray for him, follow his guidance with open hearts, and trust that through him, the Good Shepherd is leading His Church forward.

This Good Shepherd Sunday also invites us to reflect personally on how we can respond to God’s call—whether in ordained ministry, consecrated life, or committed Christian witness in the world. The Church needs shepherds who walk with their people, and the world longs for voices of truth and compassion.

May we continue to pray for Pope Leo XIV and entrust his papacy to the loving care of the Good Shepherd. And may the Lord of the harvest send generous laborers into His vineyard—perhaps even from our own parish.

Let us walk forward together, as one flock, with one Shepherd.
